**(June 5-9, 2017) Building with Legos™: Future Engineers and Architects**

Children love Legos®! They will learn to build and create buildings, villages, vehicles and other fantastical moving objects. Children will work in multiple types of groups to develop teamwork skills, as well as individual activities.



**(June 12-16, 2017) Walking in Their Footsteps:**

**San Antonio a Bilingual and Bicultural Journey**

Children will be immersed in a Bilingual and Bicultural learning experience. They will explore the wonders of our great city, San Antonio, through stories, creative play and the arts. This experience is meant to expose children to Spanish and English languages. Children will create their own book of words and their meanings.

**(June 19-23, 2017) I'm a Botanist: Science in our Natural World**

There are about 400,000 plant species on Earth. Plants keep us alive, as sources of medicine, oxygen, and food. Children will learn about plants and build a small garden to grow their own plants, as well as environmentally safe alternatives to chemicals that destroy the earth. Children will take home their garden and their own written book of Botany and Gardening.



**(June 26-30, 2017) A Journey into Outer Space:**

From Science to Science Fiction, space gives us much to learn and think about. We will start by learning about ancient times and how people read the stars to now and what we know about the stars and what is in space. We will enjoy the fun of creating monsters from outer space and end with a "Space Party."

**(July 10-14, 2017) Adventures Under the Sea:**

From seashells to fantastic creatures there is another world under the ocean. We will look at what we know by the seashore to what is out in its depth. We will learn about what is beyond what we know about the ocean then look at what is real and what is made up about the ocean. We will learn about some of the stories of monsters in the deep and look at movies and pictures of the real creatures under the sea.





### **(July 17-21, 2017) The Great DaVinci: Art in its Many Forms**

Leonardo DaVinci was one of the world's greatest artists; he used many mediums to create his works of art. Children will work in multiple mediums to create their own art and learn about great artists and how they created their works. Local artists will join the children to lend their expertise. The week concludes with an art exhibit by the children and the artists in residency.

### **(July 31-Aug 4, 2017) Everything Dinosaur**

Dinosaurs roamed this earth about 240 million years ago, and dominated the world for 175 million years. We are all fascinated with them and children can never seem to get enough. This week we will look at the archeology of dinosaurs and how, based on scientific evidence, we know what they look like. We will also look at the timeline of our planet and determine when and how long the dinosaurs lived. We will look at different types of dinosaurs and categorize them. The children will build an outdoor diorama so that they can play with the dinosaur toys. Finally, we will build our own science fiction story.
